## RESOLUTION FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE COMBINATON/REVISION AND INCLUSION OF PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL FEE SCHEDULES IN THE TOWN OF CHESWOLD

Whereas, the Town Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section 4.2.25, authorizes the Town Council to provide for and preserve the health, peace and safety, cleanliness, ornament, good order and public welfare of the Town and its' inhabitants; and

Whereas, the Town Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section 4.2.33, authorizes the Town Council to provide for payment of any tax, fine, penalty, license, forfeiture, assessment, fee, charge or other amount due the Town by the performance of labor or service for the Town by any person owing the same; and

**Whereas**, the Town Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section, 4.2.34, authorizes the Town Council to regulate and control the manner of building, moving, or removal of dwellings of other structures and may provide for granting permits for the same within the Town; and

Whereas, the Town Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section, 4.2.40, authorizes the Town Council to grant licenses, and impose fees for licenses, issue permits, and regulate any activity within the corporate limits of the Town; and

Whereas. the Town Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section 4.2.48 authorizes the Town Council to make, adopt, and establish, alter and amend all such Ordinances, Regulations, Rules and By-Laws not contrary to the laws of this State and the United States as the Town Council may deem necessary to carry into effect any of the provisions of this Charter or any other law of the State relating generally to municipal corporations or which they may deem deem proper and necessary for the order, protection and good government of the Town.....; and

Whereas, the Mayor and Town Council have deemed it necessary to combine and revise the various fee schedules associated with business licenses, building permits, land use fees, residential inspection, violation fees; and

Whereas, the Mayor and Town Council have deemed it efficient and effective to provide electrical and plumbing inspections through the contracted Engineering firm of the Town;

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**Whereas,** the Mayor and Town Council plan to properly adopt Ordinance 07-02-18-051 which provides for the combination and revision of Town of Cheswold Fee Schedules and provides for the inclusion of plumbing and electrical inspection fees by the Engineering firm contracted by the Town; and

The Mayor and Town Council will give proper notification to the public of the proposed Ordinance in a newspaper posting.
