ANNEXATION RESOLUTION FOR THE STATE OF DELAWARE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STORAGE YARD PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TOWN OF CHESWOLD CHARTER

Whereas; the Charter of the Town of Cheswold, Section 3.1.1 and Section 3.2.1, authorizes the Town Council to consider requests from property owners to extend the boundaries of the said Town after notification of the property owners and the residents of the Town and the territory proposed to be annexed; and

Whereas; the Mayor and Council of the Town of Cheswold pursuant to the requirements of the Town Charter, deem it in the best interest of the Town of Cheswold to solicit public comment and opinion on the request for annexation of property described as the land of the State of Delaware Department of Transportation, hereby to be referred to as DelDOT, Storage Yard, consisting of two, (2), parcels totaling 4.45 acres – Tax parcels: KH 00-046-00-01-52.00 and KH 03-046.15-01-01.00. Said property lies 1,225 feet west of Morton Road on the north side of State Rte. 42 and abuts the present eastern and northern boundaries of the Town. It is partially bound on the west by the property of Stanley Johnson; on the north by the property of Harry Morgan and on the east by the property of Calvin Boggs and the Cheswold Methodist Episcopal Church; and

Whereas, the Mayor and Town Council gave proper notification of the proposed annexation to the property owners and the residents of both the Town and the territory, to be annexed upon adoption of this resolution, and;

Whereas, a Public Hearing was held by the Town Council, before the regular Town Council Meeting on the 6th day of February, 2012, beginning at 6:30 p.m., in the Cheswold Fire Hall, 371 Main Street, Cheswold, DE, who sat to hear comments and opinions from any concerned party regarding the proposed annexation of the land of the DelDOT Storage Yard, consisting of two, (2), parcels totaling 4.45 acres, in Kent County, Town of Cheswold, and;

Whereas, the Public Hearing was held and no objections or concerns were voiced against the annexation by any involved or affected party, and;

Whereas, the Town Council approved by a majority vote, Ordinance #06-09-2011-022 to allow for the conditional use of publicly owned and operated facilities using outside —uncovered storage of roadway maintenance materials, under Zone I-1 and;

Whereas, this applicant has been granted an I-1 zoning code as part of their annexation process, and;

Whereas, this resolution was duly adopted, by the Town Council and Mayor at the Town of Cheswold Town Council Meeting, held on March 5, 2012.



NOW; THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by a majority vote of the Town Council and the Mayor, that the specified properties are now annexed within the territorial limits of the Town of Cheswold.
