ORDINANCE
for the
ADOPTION of the 2018
INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE

DESCRIPTION: An Ordinance of the Town of Cheswold adopting the 2018 edition of the *International Property Maintenance Code*, regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by repealing all other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith, except for those of the State of Delaware and/or Kent County and/or the Land Use Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Cheswold, which shall have precedence in perpetuity.

Section 1. PURPOSE

This Ordinance and the 2018 edition of the International Property Maintenance Code provides for the standards for regulating and governing the condition and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures' by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and uses; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use, and the demolition of such existing structures in the Town of Cheswold; providing for the issuance of permits and collections of fees thereof, and each and all of the regulations , provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Property Maintenance Code, except those so noted in the adopted Ordinance.

Section 2. AUTHORITY to ACT

The Town Council of the Town of Cheswold has been vested with all the power possible for a municipal corporation to have under the Constitution and laws of the State of Delaware, as specified by Section 4. Powers of the Town of the Town Charter and specifically with the ability to provide for and preserve the health, peace, safety, cleanliness, ornament, good order and public welfare of the Town and its inhabitants.

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Section 3. APPLICABILITY

This **Ordinance, No. 11-16-2020-062**, shall apply except where it may conflict with the Building Ordinances, codes, statutes, rules and regulations, set forth by the State of Delaware and/or Kent County and/or the Land Use Ordinance and/or Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Cheswold, in which case the Ordinances, codes, statutes, rules and regulations of the State of Delaware and/or Kent County and/or the Land Use Ordinance and/or Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Cheswold shall apply, as applicable to the situation.

Section 4. DEFINITIONS

All applicable definitions may be found in the 2018 edition of the *International Property Maintenance Code*.

Section 5. The Town Council of the Town of Cheswold does ordain as follows:

That a certain document, two (2) copies of which are on file in the office of the Secretary/Treasurer and Town Clerk of the Town of Cheswold, being marked and designated as the *International Property Maintenance Code*, 2018 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Property Maintenance Code of the Town of Cheswold, in the State of Delaware for regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and uses; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use, and the demolition of such existing structures in the Town of Cheswold; providing for the issuance of permits and collections of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Property Maintenance Code on file in the office of the Town of Cheswold are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part thereof, as if fully set out in this Ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

Section 6. ADDITIONS; INSERTIONS; DELETIONS; MODIFICATIONS; CHANGES

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Section 7. BOARD of ADJUSTMENT

The Board of Adjustment shall exist and operate as specified in the Town of Cheswold Land Use Ordinance, Article 3 Administrative Structure, Item 3-3 Board of Adjustment and conduct meetings as specified in Article 4 Administrative Procedures, Item C-2 Burden of Proof on Applicant; Item C-3 Board of Adjustment Hearing; Item D-1 Duration, Revocation and Extension and Item D-2 Reapplications and Appeals.

All appeals associated with Property Maintenance shall be submitted and processed to and by the Board of Adjustment as specified in the Town of Cheswold Land Use Ordinance.

Section 8. VALIDITY

That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 9. LEGAL RIGHTS

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Building Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or Ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 10. POSTING

That the Town Clerk and/or Secretary/Treasurer is hereby ordered and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published by posting on the Town bulletin board, Town website and local Post Office, for a period no less than 10 business days.

Section 11. EFFECTIVE DATE

That this Ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effective from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
