Three, (3), Town Council terms of office will expire on Monday, April 1, 2024. A Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, March 26, 2024, at the Cheswold Fire Hall, to staff these positions. The Polling Place will be open from 2:00 p.m., until 7:00 p.m.

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS:

Residents wishing to run for office in the 2023 Cheswold Municipal Election must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Candidates shall file a **NOTICE of INTENTION** form to seek office. The form is available at the Town Hall.
- 2. Form must be submitted by Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 4:30 p.m.
- 3. Candidates must be at least 21 years old.
- 4. Candidates must be a resident of Cheswold for at least one year prior to the date of the election.
- 5. Candidates must be registered and qualified to vote in the election.
- 6. No person convicted of a felony, or a crime of moral turpitude shall be qualified to be a candidate for office on the Town Council.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS:

Any person shall be qualified to vote who:

- 1. On the date of the election is a citizen of the United States of America.
- 2. Is at least 18 years of age.
- 3. Is registered in the Town of Cheswold to vote.
- 4. Has been a resident of Cheswold for at least 90 days prior to the date of the Election.

VOTER REGISTRATION:

- Residents may register to vote at the Cheswold Town Hall, Monday Friday, 9:00 am 4:00 pm
- The last day for registering to vote is Friday, March 8, 2024, at 4:00 pm.
- Normal voter registration for future elections will resume on April 1, 2024.
- Residents registering to vote for the first time must show proof of identification, such as a driver's license and proof of 90-day residency in Town. A utility bill may be used for this purpose.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS:

- Absentee ballots can be obtained at the Town Hall beginning Friday, March 8, 2024, at 12:00 pm, through Monday, March 27, 2023, at 4:30 pm.
- Absentee ballots, if returned by mail must reach Town Hall by close of business Monday, March 25,
 2024; if returned by hand it may be delivered to the Cheswold Fire Hall by 7:00 pm, March 26, 2024.
- Copies of the Absentee Ballot Voting Procedures are available at Town Hall
- Absentee ballots returned in the mail must be returned in the provided self-addressed envelopes.
