AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAND USE ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CHESWOLD TO AUTHORIZE MARIJUANA-BASED BUSINESSES IN CERTAIN ZONING DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO CONDITIONAL USE APPROVAL

PURPOSE: This Ordinance amends the Land Use Ordinance of the Town of Cheswold to permit marijuana establishments in the C-2, (Highway Commercial), and I-1, (Light Industrial), AG, (Agriculture), Zoning Districts within the corporate limits of the Town, subject to conditional use approval as recommended by the Planning Commission and approved by the Town Council.
